Patents

- Australian resident patent applications
- Australian patent applications decreased overall, however the total number in 2023 was consistent with pre-pandemic annual growth rates

Emerging tech areas

- Australia is the second fastest growing destination for patent applications related to clean energy generation and storage
- Sustained growth in patent applications relating to semiconductors

Plant Breeder's Rights

- Resident applications
- -1.7% overall in 2023 Applications
- Registrations +58.5% in 2023, reaching the highest level in a decade

- Trade mark registrations (-9.9% overall

Designs

- Record increase in design applications: (+11.5%
- Australian resident applications (+24.2%)
- Design certifications (+24,1%)
- A primary driver in growth was (+10.5% in applications from China

Top 3 design classes by growth rate:

+13.3% +10.6% +26.6% Transport packaging/ Games **Transport** containers



Copyright

- In 2022 (39% of surveyed respondents consumed online content that was likely to be infringing copyright (+9% from 2021)
- 'Cultural and creative activity' contributed \$122.3 billion to the Australian economy in 2019-20
- Since 2015 ~2,000 websites infringing on copyright material have been blocked in Australia (as of December 2023)
